Entry Fee: The entry fee will be \$45.00. This will get you complete access into the event. This fee will be donated to the C-CAP scholarship fund. There will be no refund of this entry fee. Checks or Money orders can be made out to C-CAP.

Participant must present a dummy cake at the competition.

Theme: For the Love of Chocolate: The cake presented must reflect the theme of the competition.

The total dimensions of the cake (including decoration) can not exceed  
18" L x 18" W x 30" H

You have from 4pm-5pm to set up your cake.

All decoration must be edible with the exception of wire/toothpicks to attach decorations to the dummies, a cake board and the dummies themselves. \*Columns and pillars must be edible.

50% of the decoration must be chocolate.

The judges and organizers of this competition reserve the right to disqualify entries showing poor taste.

Each entry must be solely the work of the entrant.

The judging will take place from 5-6pm and the People's Choice Judging will take place from 7-9pm



Judging will be based on:

1. Design

- Theme Represented
- Shape & Overall Flow
- Technique
- Level of difficulty (flowers, sugar work, air brushing, etc.)
- Originality

2. Workmanship

- Cleanliness
- Professionalism
- Within total dimensions
