All decoration must be edible with the exception of wire/toothpicks to attach decorations to the dummies, a cake board and the dummies themselves. *Columns and pillars must be edible.

50% of the decoration must be chocolate.

The judges and organizers of this competition reserve the right to disqualify entries showing poor taste.

Each entry must be solely the work of the entrant.

The judging will begin from 5- 6 pm

People's Choice judging will be from 7 to 9 pm
